- Sold foreign coins on eBay that were donated by the Cashiers team
- Auctioned tickets
- Hosted a gig by the firm's band and sold tickets for donations
- Donated unclaimed client monies
- Held an Easter Bunny raffle
- Held a 'Guess the Amount of Jelly Beans in the Jar' competition
- Held a sponsored London to Paris bike ride
- Took part in the Standard Chartered Great City Race
- Organised a sponsored Three Peaks Challenge
- Took part in the Royal Parks Half Marathon
- Encouraged colleagues to 'Spring Clean' and donate any items to be sold on eBay and at festivals
- Held World Cup sweep stakes with a percentage of the winning funds to be donated to AATC
- Had a 'Charity of the Year' themed work party

Arms Around The Child has also had support from Worley Parsons, who have paid for AATC to have tables at a number of Freshers Fayres at the University College London and held their own 'Guess the Amount of Jelly Beans in the Jar' competitions.
